



Melag 23EN,29VS, 31B Recommissioning Guide April 2020 Rev 1.0

This document is intended as a guide to assist with the recommissioning process for the Melag 23EN, 29VS & 31B following a period of hibernation.

We recommend that the following steps be performed at the earliest opportunity, to allow sufficient time to address any unexpected issues that may arise.

Estimated Duration: 2 hours



Ensure that appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is used

- 1. Check both the clean & dirty water tanks for any residual water and/or debris. If water and/or debris are present, clean and dry the tank using good quality water and a lint free cloth
- 2. Check the door seal for signs of wear or damage. Replace as necessary. If the door seal is in good condition, clean using a mild soap/detergent
- 3. **23EN only** Clean and lubricate the threads of the door latch, door grip and door hinge using silicone grease
- 4. Remove all the chamber furniture and clean the internal chamber surfaces using a lint free cloth. Re-fit the chamber furniture once complete
- 5. Switch the power to the unit ON
- 6. Add water to the clean water tank. Once water is added to the tank, you can check the conductivity by pressing and holding the minus (-) key



Water quality should ideally measure below 5 microsiemens (μ S). A warning message will be displayed if the water quality is measured at \geq 40 μ S. The unit will not function if the water quality is measured above \geq 65 μ S.

- 7. Check the time and date are correct. Adjust as necessary
- 8. Check the data logger / Melaflash is connected
- 9. Carry out a vacuum test program as you would at the start of each day
- 10. Carry out a Bowie & Dick/Helix test program as you would at the start of each day (For 23EN, use appropriate class TST strip only)
- 11. Remove the CF/SD card and confirm that cycle data has transferred successfully
- 12. On successful completion of all tests, the equipment can be used



If you are in any doubt **WHATSOEVER** as to the condition and/or safe operation of your Melag Autoclave, you should switch OFF any power source and clearly identify the equipment as **DO NOT USE**. Contact Henry Schein Service for support.
